32 years or younger (Date of birth: on or after 1 January 1986)

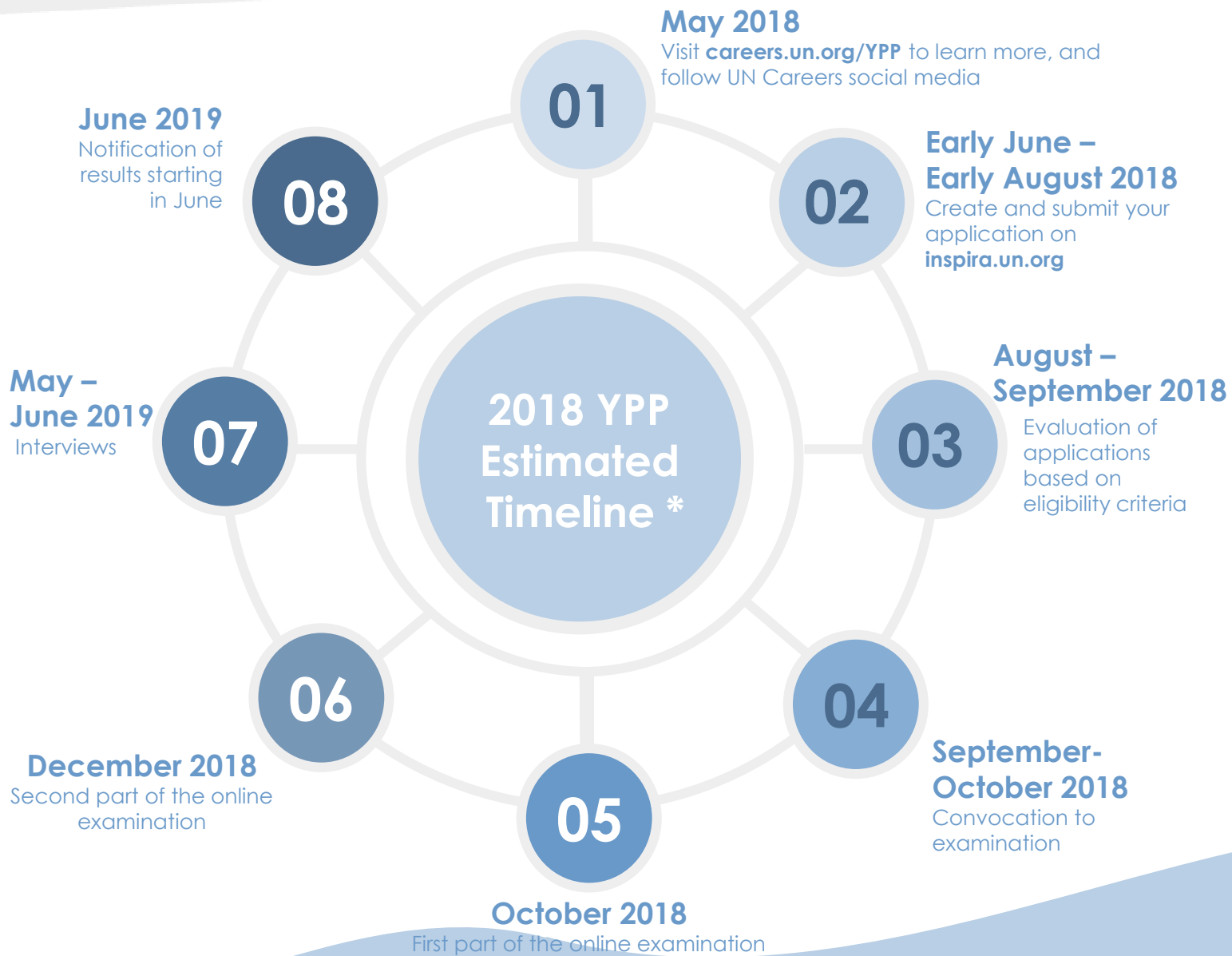
